






### Weih sien Le Dao Yuan

Weih sien Le Dao Yuan, the former site of Weifang Guangwen Middle School and Weifang People's Hospital, was famous as the foundation of missionary work, education and medical treatment. In 1881, Robert M. Mateer, missionary of the American Presbyterian Church, came to Weih sien and found it a town with convenient transportation, flourishing business and rich cultural heritage. He decided to promote religious activities in Weih sien on the basis of the advantages. In 1883, he purchased more than 50 mu of lands in the eastern part of Weih sien. Houses are built to set up the middle school, hospital and church. Then, the district was named as Le Dao Yuan. It was burned down by "Yihetuan" (known in the West as the Boxer Uprising) in 1900.

In 1902, American Presbyterian Church rebuilt Le Dao Yuan, using 14,774 taels silver from Indemnity for the 1900 War, (known in the West as Boxer Indemnity), to buy about 160 mu land. Besides the cathedral, the new-built Le Dao Yuan had middle school and hospitals, among them were Guangwen College, Wenhua High School, Wenhua Middle School. There were nurse schools attached to the hospitals.




